

International Workshop / Symposium Proposal by Invited Speakers (YOU-LEAD 2026)

Program Overview

YOU-LEAD 2026 provides a flexible workshop and symposium platform designed specifically for invited speakers who wish to propose and lead their own specialized sessions. This model supports academic creativity, international collaboration, and the development of new interdisciplinary research networks across education, digital transformation, and STEM-related fields. Invited speakers may design workshop formats that reflect their expertise, including half-day focused sessions, panel discussions, research clusters, methodological training workshops, thematic symposia, or collaborative project meetings.

Format and Features

Session Structure Options

Invited speakers may choose one of the following models:

- Half-day workshop (3–4 hours) with hands-on or thematic focus
- Mini-symposium with 3–4 invited presentations
- Roundtable discussion featuring multi-perspective dialogue
- Research collaboration meeting (MoI or bilateral cooperation focus)
- Methodological training or software demonstration session

Key Features

- Full freedom to set the theme, scope, and agenda
- Support from SCITEED Secretariat for scheduling and logistics
- Opportunity to include PhD students, colleagues, or collaborators
- Sessions may lead to joint publications or project proposals
- Optional collaboration agreements (MoI) may be signed during the congress

Proposal Guidelines

Invited speakers who wish to organize a YOU-LEAD 2026 session are encouraged to submit a short proposal including:

- Proposed workshop/symposium title
- Session format (workshop, mini-symposium, roundtable, etc.)
- Brief abstract (150–250 words)
- Expected number of speakers or participants
- Preferred duration (half-day or extended)
- Required technical setup (projectors, XR demos, software, etc.)

SCITEED 2026 strongly encourages innovative, interdisciplinary contributions spanning digital learning, AI in education, XR environments, STEM & coding, wellbeing and safe schools, inclusion, and other emerging research areas aligned with the conference themes.
